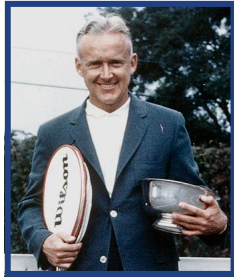


**Dr. W. Minster Kunkel  
1924-2006**



The beloved and respected general & thoracic surgeon was also a dedicated athlete and tennis was his passion! He became the Augusta, GA city tennis champion in 1948 and owned the first indoor tennis facility in Harrisburg in 1967.

He received his B.S. degree from Franklin & Marshall College in 1943 while playing the #1 spot on the tennis team.

Dr. Kunkel was with the Kunkel Surgical Group from 1955 to 1994. In a distinguished professional career he attained many prominent positions.

At Harrisburg Hospital he was Chief of Thoracic Surgery (1965-85) as well as Chairman of the Surgery Department (1978-85) and Chairman & Director of the Surgery Education Department (1979-81).

At Holy Spirit Hospital, Chief of Thoracic Surgery (1963-86). At Milton S. Hershey Medical Center's Penn State College of Medicine he served as Clinical Professor of Surgery.

He was President of both the Central Pennsylvania College of Surgeons (1973) and Pennsylvania Association of Thoracic Surgeons (1980).
